Professor Luca Bianchi is Associate Professor in Dermatology at the Tor Vergata University of Rome, Italy. Since 2008, he is the Director of the School of Specialty in Dermatology and Venereology at the same University, and in 2016, he became Chair of the Department of Dermatology at the Fondazione Policlinico Tor Vergata, University Hospital, Rome, Italy. He received his medical degree in 1982 at the University of Rome "La Sapienza".

In 1984, he joined as post-degree research fellow the Department of Dermatology of the Wayne State University, Detroit, Michigan, USA, to study cutaneous electron microscopy and monoclonal antibodies production. In 1988, he was a visiting scientist at the American Health Foundation, Valhalla, New York, USA, to investigate melanoma cell molecular biology and in 2010, as visiting professor, followed the in- and out-patient clinics of the Dermatology Clinic of the Charité Hospital, in Berlin, Germany. Professor Bianchi's clinical and experimental research interests include protocols on anti-neoplastic agents on NMSC, definition of peripheral and tissutal markers for melanoma and morphological, immunophenotical and ultrastructural description or rare inflammatory and neoplastic dermatoses.

He is actively involved in conducting clinical trials in IMIDs and neoplastic disorders. He has published more than 200 peer-reviewed scientific papers, contributed to book chapters, lectured at national and international meetings and acts as reviewer of several international journals on dermatology. He is member of dermatological national and international societies and also participated in the organization of several national and international scientific meetings.
