Maria Concetta Fargnoli is Associate Professor of Dermatology and Chairman of the Department of Dermatology at the University of L'Aquila, Italy. She received her medical degree in 1992 at the University of Rome "Tor Vergata", completed her residency in Dermatology at the University of L'Aquila in 1998 and obtained the National Scientific Qualification as Full Professor in 2013. She is the Director of the Interdepartmental Centre of Molecular Diagnostics and Advanced Therapies, Director of the Laboratory of Molecular Biology in Dermato-Oncology and Faculty of the PhD Program in Experimental Medicine at the University of L'Aquila.

Her clinical and experimental research interests include epidemiology and genetics of melanoma and non-melanoma skin cancers, dermoscopy, role of pigmentation genes in melanoma susceptibility, new therapeutic interventions for inflammatory and neoplastic skin diseases. She is actively involved in conducting clinical trials.

She has published more than 130 peer-reviewed scientific papers, contributed to many book chapters and lectured at national and international meetings. Prof. Fargnoli acts as board member of the Giornale Italiano di Dermatologia e Venereologia, reviewer of international journals on dermatology and genetics and referee for ANVUR (National Agency for the Evaluation of Universities and Research Institutes).
