Caterina Foti is born in Bari where she lives, attended the University and specialized in Dermatology and Venereology. From 1st November 1998 she had been working at the University of Bari as Associate Professor in Dermatology.

Nowadays she is the Director of the Dermatology Clinic of the University of Bari, President of the Italian Society of Dermatology, Allergology, Environmental and Professional (SIDAPA), member of the European Environmental and Contact Dermatitis Research Group (EECDRG).

She is the author of over 200 scientific publications in national and international journals, 32 chapters and a monograph on various topics. She participated in numerous national and international conferences as speaker and chairman. Her main scientific interests are in the study of contact dermatitis, photo-dermatitis and urticaria.

Her scientific activity is focused to the research of the substances responsible of contact allergy trying also to identify new sensitizing haptens. Several studies have been conducted regarding contact dermatitis to cosmetics including etiological, pathogenetical, clinical and diagnostical observations.
