## **ANGELO VALERIO MARZANO**

Professor Marzano has obtained his medical degree from the University of Milan with an excellent score (110/110 con lode). After graduation he received his medical training in dermatology in the University of Milan and became a board-certified specialist in dermatology with an excellent score (70/70 con lode). Since 2000 he has been working with the *Unità Ospedaliera di Dermatologia* della Fondazione IRCCS Ca' Granda - Ospedale Maggiore Policlinico, Milano, where he worked as senior fellow and chief of the Dermatology inpatient ward.

He is author of several studies (case series, retrospective and prospective series, unique case reports), which have been published in the best dermatological journals, in very good journals of other disciplines (hematology, nephrology, rheumatology...) as well as in more basic and investigative immunological journals. He has more than 150-peer reviewed publications and is author of many book chapters.

His current clinical and research interests are focused on immune-mediated, autoinflammatory and systemic diseases, in which he has gained broad knowledge and an internationally recognized expertise. His strength consists of a solid and broad clinical expertise associated with an excellent knowledge of the underlying pathogenetic pathways.

He described clinical entities inside the neutrophilic dermatoses'spectrum, such as the aseptic pustulosis of the folds and the PAPASH syndrome, and published many studies on other neutrophilic dermatoses. His studies on the cells and cytokines implicated in auto-inflammation and neutrophilic dermatoses are on the forefront of dermatological research and help to better understand these complex conditions.

Based on his expertise, Professor Marzano is frequently invited to national and international congresses as well appreciated chairman or speaker, particularly at the EADV from 2010 until now and at the World Congress Of Dermatology (8-14 Jul 2015) in Vancouver.

Furthermore, he acts as associate editor or as reviewer for a variety of peer-reviewed dermatological or internal medicine journals.

He was Chairman of the "Italian Group of Immunodermatology" of the Italian Society of Dermatology (SIDEMAST).
