Giuseppe Monfrecola (from 2004) is Full Professor and Chairman of Dermatology and Director of the Residency Training Program in Dermatology and Venereology (Department of Clinical Medicine and Surgery, University Federico II, Naples-Italy).

He was Graduate in Medicine and Surgery (1975, University of Naples Federico II, Italy) and completed his residency in Dermatology and Venereology in 1978 at the same University.

He has been Assistant Dermatologist (1977-1982), Research Fellow (1982-1990) and Associate Professor of Dermatology (1990-2003). He has been a founder of the Italian Society on Photobiology, member of the Photomedicine Society, member of the Board of the European Academy of Dermatology and Venereology (2007-2010) and of the Italian Society of Dermatology and Venereology (SIDeMaST).

He has been the scientific coordinator of the Italian group of Photodermatology of SIDeMaST. He is member of the Faculty of the PhD Program in Experimental Medicine at the University Federico II- Naples, Italy. His clinical and experimental research interest include photoprotection, photocarcinogenesis, melanogenesis and inflammatory skin disease such as acne, rosacea, hidradenitis suppurativa.

He has been invited speaker in more than 300 international and Italian scientific meetings and author and coauthor of 38 chapters of books and 337 articles and reviewer of international journals on dermatology and photobiology.
