is recognized for her expertise and research in hair diseases and neurodermatology. She is the current President of the North American Hair Research Society, immediate past chair of the Clinical Research Advisory Council of the National Alopecia Areata Foundation, past president of the Association of Professors of Dermatology and is a representative from the Association to the Council of Faculty and Academic Societies of the American Association of Medical Colleges. Dr. Hordinsky is also a member of the Board of Directors of the Cicatricial Alopecia Research Foundation and is Section Editor on Hair Diseases for UpToDate, an evidence-based clinical decision support system. She is actively involved in several dermatology organizations and in 2018, received the Mentor of the Year Award from the Women's Dermatological Society. Dr. Hordinsky has over 100 publications. She regularly lectures and teaches on hair diseases and divides her time between seeing patients with trainees and doing clinical research, teaching, and administration at the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis, Minnesota, USA.
